
WHEREAS, personal information maintained by the Most Worshipful Grand Lodge of the State of Arkansas was shared with a non-Masonic entity outside of the state of Arkansas;

WHEREAS, this information was shared without the common knowledge of the Masonic body within the jurisdiction of the Most Worshipful Grand Lodge of the State of Arkansas;

WHEREAS, the sharing of this personal information could endanger certain Masons due to their personal employ;

WHEREAS, there was no opportunity given for any Mason residing in the jurisdiction of the Most Worshipful Grand Lodge of the State of Arkansas to opt out of the sharing of this personal information;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Cabot Lodge 319, by a majority vote of its membership in attendance at its stated meeting, is recommending a change to the by-laws of the Most Worshipful Grand Lodge of the State of Arkansas to NOT allow the sharing of ANY personal information of any Mason within the jurisdiction of the Most Worshipful Grand Lodge of the State of Arkansas without a vote of either each Lodge in good standing within the jurisdiction of the Most Worshipful Grand Lodge of the State of Arkansas, separately, or by a vote of the attending body at the Grand Session of the Most Worshipful Grand Lodge of the State of Arkansas.
